POCKLINGTON TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

Meeting of the Town Council Meeting Room Old Courthouse George Street Pocklington Wednesday 12th September 2012 at 7pm

Present: Councillors Marron (Chairman), Cooper, Cox, Jones, Perry, Ratcliffe, Shepherd, Spademan, Sykes, Taylor & West. Four members of the public, a member of the press & the clerk.

Before the start of the meeting Councillor Alan Spademan led the Council in prayers.

- 1. To receive any apologies for absence. All were present.
- 2. To receive any declarations of interest in relation to any agenda item. Councillors are asked to declare their interest as either pecuniary or non-pecuniary. None were given.
- 3. Consider closing the meeting to allow an opportunity for person(s) or groups to address the council for a period of up to 15 minutes. Paul Davison a candidate for the Humberside Police & Crime Commissioners post has asked to address the council about his bid. Tiffany Barker has also asked to speak to us about a possible drop-in centre. Cllr. Sykes proposed closing the meeting 2nd Cllr Perry and agreed. Recently retired Ch. Supt. Paul Davison spoke about his candidacy for the post of Crime Commissioner. The election is to be held on 15th November. He said it represents the biggest change in policing for 200years. The Commissioner will replace the Police Authority and will be in charge of policing. His vision is to be in charge of the best Police Force in the country. After languishing low down in the ratings it now has one of the best burglary rates it averages only 1.5 per day in 'C' div.
- 4. Consider re-opening the meeting proposed by Cllr Ratcliffe, 2nd Cllr Perry & agreed.
- 5. Consider the Arts Centre Managers report. James Duffy presented his report on the last months activities (report attached) which was pleasing. Councillors congratulated all who have worked hard to achieve the good results. Janet Farmer presented the financial report to the end of June which shows a profit of £5,154 (this does include the £4,000 donation for digitization from the Friends). Both were thanked for their support and hard work.
- 6. To confirm the minutes of the Town Council meeting held on 8th August 2012 Proposed by Cllr Sykes 2nd Cllr West and agreed.
- 7. To report matters arising from those minutes not on the agenda for information only. None raised.

- 8. Consider the letter recently received from Les Waby re floods. After a discussion it was agreed to invite Mr Waby to the meeting on 21st November when progress reports will be received from both the EA & ERYC.
- 9. Receive an update on the right of way at Pocklington Cemetery. The officer from ERYC has written to the church authorities to ask if they have records of the land being consecrated. Once a reply has been received she will come to one of our council meetings to discuss the best way forward.
- 10. Consider applications from councillors for the vacant post of Governor at Pocklington School Nominations were received from Cllrs Martin Cooper & Graham Perry. Cllr Marron suggested that the item be moved to the closed part of the meeting which was agreed.
- 11. Update on the fact checking of the allocations DPD A group of councillors had discussed the marking of the allocations and several amendments were suggested. These have been sent to ERYC & the documents to now be circulated to other members.
- 12. Discuss the arrangements for co-opting two new councillors. It was agreed to get the Pocklington Post to run a feature on the vacancies asking for nominations.
- 13. Receive a verbal report from our district councillors. None were present. It was agreed that a letter should be sent to each of our district councillors asking for one of them to attend each meeting.
- 14. To receive the financial statement of
 - (a) Pocklington Town Council and agree payments
 - (b) Consider the bank statements, and agree payments from Pocklington Arts Centre.

These were proposed by Cllr Shepherd & 2nd Cllr Cooper & agreed.

- 17. The Police are visiting Broadmanor playpark regularly to check on the problem.
- 18. It was agreed to write a letter to the landowner who rears the ducks.
- 31. Cllr Perry proposed the quote from Rotherhams of £1677.50 for a memorial stone into which the Queen Elizabeth playing field plaques would be fitted should be accepted. 2^{nd} Cllr Sykes and agreed.

The ERNLLA day conference on 3rd November is aimed at new councillors and would be worth attending.

- 17. Consider the Town Clerk's report. The report was noted It was agreed to postpone the Road safety meeting scheduled for next week until early October because of annual leave. It was agreed to stop using the fuel card until the garage becomes a BP outlet. A discussion took place about the taking down of the bunting. It was agreed because it is now looking tired it should be taken down. A vote was taken on whether to retain the flags at the Arts Centre. 8 voted for 2against with 1 abstention. Cllr Perry proposed that we employ Terry Melia initially for 10hours to paint the benches in town. 2nd Cllr Cooper and agreed.
- 18. Consider and agree the minutes of the Policy & Resources committee on 22nd August 2012 Proposed by Cllr Cox 2nd Sykes & agreed.
- 19. Receive reports from any other meetings Gateway etc.

10. Cllr Marron proposed 'That in view of the confidential nature of the business about to be transacted, it is advisable in the public interest that the

press and public be temporarily excluded and they are instructed to withdraw'. 2nd Cllr Shepherd and agreed. The members of the public then left and both Cllr Cooper & Cllr Perry were given three minutes to address the council on why they should be considered for nomination to be a Governor at Pocklington School. Both councillors were then asked to leave the room whilst the matter was further discussed. A ballot was then held where 4 abstained, 4 voted for Cllr Perry and 1 for Cllr Cooper. Cllr Perry was therefore the Council's nomination.
