ACTIVITIES
Pocklington has its own **Francis Scaife Leisure Centre** with a popular gym and swimming pool. For those looking for something more unusual the **Wolds Gliding Club**, sited on the World War II bomber base, offers lessons and flights over the Yorkshire Wolds, and there is a water sports and activity centre nearby.
Pocklington Canal is a nine-and-a-half-mile waterway from Pocklington to the River Derwent via Melbourne, which hosts weekend canal boat trips. No longer in commercial use, it is now one of Britain's finest waterways for wildlife, with **Canal Head** a favoured picnic spot and walking route.

WALKING AND CYCLING AROUND POCKLINGTON
Pocklington is a 'Walkers are Welcome' town and recognised as a Cycling Centre, linked to numerous short and longer distance walks and rides; including the Yorkshire Wolds Way national trail for walkers and Way of the Roses coast to coast cycle route.

EVENTS
There is a regular series of major events and festivals held in the town including a **Summer Fair** on West Green, the **Flying Man Festival**, **Pocktoberfest** and the **Good Friday rugby 7s**. Burnby Hall Gardens has a full programme of spring, summer and autumn events including regular band concerts. Many nearby villages have a big summer event, amongst them traditional country shows and summer fetes.
