1. Notice of meeting.

The damaged barrier on Garths End/Yapham Road junction has been reported.

The keep left sign on Percy Road close to the junction with Kilnwick Road has been hit and is loose.

A collapsing drain on New Street has been reported.

8. Consider any further road safety suggestions for forwarding to East Riding of Yorkshire Council for consideration.

Woldgate parents are again parking on the single yellow lines round St Helen's Close. The parking enforcement officer does monitor this area and a request to go up there again will be made.

The railway footpath (West Green car park to Barmby Road) could this be added to the salting routes for the Town Council. The clerk to add this to the routes for salting.

Discussion on the single yellow line on Chapmangate and whether this was needed. After a discussion decided to leave as is.
